## Sweepstakes

Entry is made at the same time as entries for the Regular Classes and on the Official AKC Entry Form which should be marked "Sweepstakes" in the space for "Additional Classes."

## Classification

### Puppy Sweepstakes

ALL Sweepstakes puppies MUST also be entered in a Regular Class. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes.

Eligibility: The Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Shetland Sheepdogs eligible for competition in the Regular AKC Classes whose age will be no less than 6 months and no greater than 18 months on the day of judging. The exception is as follows: NO DOG HAVING COMPLETED THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A CHAMPIONSHIP PRIOR TO THE DAY OF JUDGING SHALL COMPETE IN PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES.

### SYCAMORE LANE KENNELS

From I-5- Take the Kettleman Lane/Hwy 12 exit (Lodi/Rio Vista). Head East for 1.3 miles to Ray Road. Turn Left onto Ray Road and go almost one mile to the first curve. At the curve, turn left onto Sargent Road and follow the signs to Sycamore Kennels and the show site.

From Hwy 99- Take the Kettleman/Hwy 12 exit. Proceed through Lodi. From the last traffic signal (Lower Sacramento Road), it is 8.0 miles to Ray Road. Turn right onto Ray Road. At the curve, turn left onto Sargent Road and follow the signs to Sycamore Lane Kennels and the show site.

## Day Of Show Parking

Parking is provided and managed by ALL SPORTS DOG PARK LLC AND SYCAMORE LANE KENNELS AND FARM. Day of show parking is available on a limited basis at a fee of \$5.00 per vehicle per day. INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
