Awards: Flat ribbons will be awarded 1st—4th place in each jump height class to dogs with qualifying scores. Green ribbons will be awarded for each qualifying score. Dogs earning the MACH or PACH title will receive a special Rosette and pole. Master level dogs earning a Double, Triple, Quadruple, Quintuple or Sextuple Q will receive a corresponding pin.

Move-Up Regulations: Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. Day-to-day move-ups are allowed providing the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing, within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course.

Course Walk Through / Warm Up Area: Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of a class. The walk through is restricted to handlers entered in the class. A warmup jump will be provided for each ring.

Class Information and Obstacles: Classes offered: Regular Titling: Novice A & B, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Preferred: Novice, Open, Master/Excellent for Standard, JWW, FAST and T2B. Regular and Preferred Premier Standard and JWW. Owners are responsible for entering the proper class. Each day judging will rotate between two rings beginning in the Standard ring. Event is unlimited. If entry numbers exceed 330 on any day, then a second Judge will officiate the overage. Brian Ferrand will design all courses.

Notice to Exhibitors

- The Agility Trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners dogs provided their listing number has been recorded on entry form
- Agility Running order will be determined by random draw. Handlers with more than one dog in a class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- If a dog and/or handler are dismissed, regardless of reason, there will be NO refund of entry fee.
- All refunds will be sent, by check, seven days after the event.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by Action of the Trial Committee
- No entry fee will refunded if the trial cannot be open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, weather, public emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Organizing Committee
- Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry form. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be accepted or entered in the event.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund on any fees paid will be made. This includes Entry Fees and RV Fees
- All dogs must always be on leash except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn.
- Please be courteous and pick up after your dog.
- Dogs under four months of age are prohibited at AKC Events
- Do not leave animals unattended in vehicles. The Club will not be responsible for damage to vehicles resulting from the rescue of overheated animals.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Rabies vaccine in required in the State of California

AGREEMENT

I certify that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, I (we) agree to abide by the rules and regulations of The American Kennel Club in effect at the time of this event, and any additional rules and regulations appearing in the premium list of this event and entry form and any decision made in accord with them. I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other person. I (we) agree that the determination of whether the injury is serious shall be made by the event veterinarian and is binding on me (us).

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN THIS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
