New treatment for acute diarrhea

Pro-Kolin Advanced - it is an anti-diarrhea probiotic paste.

Treatment for puppies with parvovirus

Canine Parvovirus Monoclonal Antibody injection. single dose injection IV.

Discolored teeth

Caused by trauma to the teeth such as playing tug with a ball. Blood leaks into the dentin and causes the discoloration. Most discolored teeth are non-vital and require xrays. Treatment- root canal or extraction




